



2021 Petit Verdot

Vineyard

Sourced from historic Windrow Vineyard which has a rare combination of heat during the day followed by a cool breeze flowing out of the Blue Mountains in the evenings. This allows the grapes to grow later in the season, increasing maturity while retaining acidity. Windrow varies from deep deposits of windblown loess to shallow layers over gravelly cobble. Petit Verdot thrives in a climate like this since it needs the extra time to become expressive in flavors and develop more depth in body.

Winemaker Notes

"Petit Verdot is seldom done by itself since it's harder to get ripe but the hot, dry, and windy conditions on Windrow really harnesses its potential and this has become one of my favorite blocks to work with. I have found that a bit of new oak benefits the wine immensely and this vintage turned out bigger and bolder than I expected...in a good way."~Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

Petit Verdot...usually blended but now making its own way in the world! Due to the addition of some new French oak, this wine is beefier than our prior vintage with aromas of violets, Angelino plums, blackberries, and dark cherries, all of which are completely mirrored on the palate and combined with medium tannins and body, leave no question that Petit Verdot can stand on its own. A thought provoking sipper. Drink 2024-2031.
