



2021 Riesling

Vineyard

One of Walla Walla's premier vineyards, Les Collines Vineyard (The Foothills in French) lies at the base of the Blue Mountains in Walla Walla Valley. The soil is mostly Walla Walla Silt Loam, with some Athena Silt Loam resting on top of ancient gravel. Les Collines tends to have a longer than average growing season, warmer in the morning, cooler than average in the afternoon, and a greater number of growing degree days, making it perfect for Riesling.

Winemaker Notes

"This was a little later pick and lower acid than past vintages. I wanted to try something a bit more off-dry since we had already made a bone dry version. I used a different yeast for this one too and it didn't quite turn out the way I thought it would...ending up with a slight spritz. It was an educational vintage for me."~Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

Leave it to our last vintage to be the most surprising! Beautiful notes of juicy, ripe Granny Smith apples and hints of Asian pear with a tiny bit of that awesome petrol note we all love in a dry Riesling. But the biggest surprise is the effervescence! That's right...this wine has tiny bubbles that tickle the nose initially but melt away gently...making room for the big fruit flavors.
