E'ritage, although young, has amazing potential and is already producing incredible fruit. Managed by a fellow WWCC alumni, these fertile hills are packed full of the terroir that has earned the Walla Walla Valley a place among the leading wine regions of the world. We have been sourcing the same block of Syrah since our first harvest and we can't get over how dark and brooding the wines turn out. Eritage is a warmer site so the fruit gets really ripe, resulting in deep, dark, and somewhat reductive nuances.

Winemaker Notes

"4th year of working with Block 10...we've always been really happy with how it turns out so I set out to maintain the dark characteristics that we have come to love. Tasting Notes

The final vintage of Syrah from Eritage Vineyard...and let's just say we've saved the best for last. This is the dark and brooding monster you've come to know and love! Aromas of forest floor, black and blue fruits, and purple flowers followed by full flavors of red fruit preserves (raspberries, cherries, currants, cranberries) and uncured salami. The finish is long and satisfying with a reductive note that makes you want to sit by the fireplace and relax.
