



# 2022 Roussanne

#### Vineyard

One of Walla Walla's premier vineyards, Les Collines Vineyard (The Foothills in French) lies at the base of the Blue Mountains in Walla Walla Valley. The soil is mostly Walla Walla Silt Loam, with some Athena Silt Loam resting on top of ancient gravel. Les Collines tends to have a longer than average growing season, warmer in the morning, cooler than average in the afternoon, and a greater number of growing degree days, making it perfect for white wine grapes.

### Winemaker Notes

"I was looking to replace Riesling and love the crispness of Roussanne. I wasn't 100% sure what to expect having never worked with this grape but I was hoping it would turn out to be a light-bodied, crisp white wine with good acid...something nice for summer that would complement summertime foods."~ Josh Roznowski

## **Tasting Notes**

After being handed an opportunity to source Roussanne, Josh set out to create a wine that is aciddriven, crisp, and light-bodied. While often blended, this vintage stands on its own with flavors of Meyer lemon and ripe lime, white flowers, and a wisp of honeycomb. Pair with sushi or a sous vide pork chop. Drink 2023-2026.
