We took this vintage of Cabernet from our friends at E'ritage Vineyard. A relatively young vineyard, E'ritage has amazing potential and is already producing incredible fruit. Managed by a fellow WWCC alumni, these fertile hills are packed full of the terrior that has earned the Walla Walla Valley a place among the leading wine regions of the world.

Winemaker Notes

"The one I almost poured down the drain! It was challenging and uncooperative so I finally decided to bottle it and put it in the corner until it decided to behave. I used 50% Eastern European oak instead of French for this one. I had used European on the 2016 Merlot and thought it would be fun to try on a Cab. Aged 18 months in barrel and just about 6 months in bottle, it came together better than I ever could've hoped. Age worthy without a doubt." ~ Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

You may have tasted what our Chardonnay and Syrah from this vineyard are like and this Cabernet follows suit with enticing aromas of black cherry, bakers chocolate, and sagebrush followed by a palate of bright and mouthwatering blackberries, cherries, and Damson plums. It's a cornucopia of mixed dark fruits with the tannins you would expect from a big Cab. An age worthy wine that will pair well with any cut of red meat!
