



2019 Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard

From historic Windrow Vineyard, these are some of the oldest Cabernet grapes in Walla Walla Valley. Planted in 1980, Windrow has a rare combination of heat during the day followed by a cool breeze flowing out of the Blue Mountains in the evenings. This allows the grapes to grow later in the season, increasing maturity while retaining acidity. Windrow varies from deep deposits of windblown loess to shallow layers over gravelly cobble.

Winemaker Notes

"I was excited to work with these 40 year old vines from Windrow Vineyard and wanted to develop classic Cabernet flavors. Using 66% new Eastern European oak rounded out the bold fruit flavors in the wine...adding a softer mouthfeel and finish which I feel is just as important as flavor and aroma. I'm very happy with how this turned out and it's drinking great...but if you can wait until fall of 2022 to really get into it, you'll be happy you did. " ~ Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

Take some time with your nose in the glass...it's worth it... blackberries, Chelan cherries, black currants, and a refreshing hint of cranberry are intertwined with aromas of hawthorne, bramble, and a touch of coffee. Fine, round tannins and a full body greet you on first sip with flavors of freshly picked blueberries, sun-kissed blackberries, a pop of mulberry and a touch of sage. This vintage weighs nicely on the tongue with concentrated flavors and a LONG finish. Savor this one, my friends, it's a winner! Drink 2022-2034.
