Cockburn Ranch Vineyard is located in the Southeast corner of the valley in the foothills of the Blue Mountains. 180 plantable acres in well drained, deep, silty-loam with an elevation of 1100 - 1300 ft. Varieties planted here are Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay and many others making it very appealing to winemakers from all over.

Winemaker Notes

"I was going for a larger, more ripe Chardonnay with more new French oak for added complexity. The trick here is balancing fruit and oak so the end result is a large, round wine with big flavors nuanced by oak." ~ Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

From the first breath in, you know it's an oaked Chardonnay but you are intrigued by the graceful nature of its presence. The nose is pronounced with coconut, tropical fruits, and a hint of lemon curd. On the palate, the flavors are fresh and juicy with the oak a bit playful in the background. A fun wine with complexity...what more could you possibly need?
