



# 2019 Grenache

### Vineyard

Cockburn Ranch Vineyard is located in the Southeast corner of the valley in the foothills of the Blue Mountains. 180 plantable acres in well drained, deep, silty-loam with an elevation of 1100 - 1300 ft. Varieties planted here are Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay and many others making it very appealing to winemakers from all over.

#### Winemaker Notes

"We switched to a new vineyard source with higher elevation for this vintage so I knew this would be a more finesse-driven wine. I really tried to integrate that bright acidity with the tried and true flavors of Grenache. No new oak...just let the grape do the talking. Even with the shortened growing season due to the unexpected freeze, we still made a fantastic wine that shows you just how beautiful and complex Grenache can be."~ Joshua Roznowski

# **Tasting Notes**

The aromatics jump out of the glass with this wine...cherry pie and rhubarb with notes of baking spice and white pepper intermingle with lavender and violets. The mouthfeel is surprisingly smooth and light with racy red fruits like currants, cranberries, just ripe strawberries, and pomegranates. The finish is extraordinarily long so enjoy it!
