



# 2019 Syrah

## Vineyard

E'ritage, although young, has amazing potential and is already producing incredible fruit. Managed by a fellow WWCC alumni, these fertile hills are packed full of the terroir that has earned the Walla Walla Valley a place among the leading wine regions of the world. We loved the 2018 Syrah from Eritage Vineyard so we stuck with it in 2019. Eritage is a warmer site so the fruit can get really ripe. Josh is a big fan of a dark, brooding, reductive Syrah and as you know, we make what we like to drink! He also believes Syrah should be a monster....deep, dark, and meaty.

#### Winemaker Notes

"With our Syrah quickly becoming a fan favorite in the tasting room I really didn't want to change too many things. I kept the same oak program and stuck with the 10% whole cluster as well to get that inky dark and brooding Syrah. I even kept the same block...Block 10 but I had to watch it closely as it can ripen (and overripen) really fast. I think this one is right in line with the 2018 but a touch brighter and will begin to hit its stride in June of 2022."~ Joshua Roznowski

# **Tasting Notes**

The nose is complex with aromas of fresh olives, purple flowers, dark berries, and black plums. With a slightly brighter palate than last year, this vintage boasts super supple tannins with juicy flavors of huckleberry, boysenberry, and a pop of sage. Enjoy this one...savor it...because once you take a sip, it's going to be gone! Decant for an hour while young. Drink 2022-2034.
