Vineyard

Cockburn Ranch Vineyard is located in the Southeast corner of the valley in the foothills of the Blue Mountains. 180 plantable acres in well drained, deep, silty-loam with an elevation of 1100 - 1300 ft. We sourced Grenache this year but other varieties planted here are Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay and many others making it very appealing to winemakers from all over.

Winemaker Notes

"We switched to this new vineyard source with higher elevation so I knew this would be a more finesse-driven wine. I really tried to integrate that bright acidity with the tried and true flavors of Grenache. No new oak...just let the grape do the talking. With an almost perfect growing season, we got a fantastic wine that rivals that infamous 2018 vintage...once again highlighting how beautiful and complex Grenache can be."~ Joshua Roznowski

This vintage of Grenache opens with aromas of red fruits, cinnamon, sandalwood, and a pop of green peppercorn. Medium bodied and garnet in color, the flavors of cherry, vanilla, and baking spice envelop all the senses as you sip. This is truly just a happy wine...pair it with friends and lots of laughter.
