



# 2020 Mourvédre

## Vineyard

Los Rocosos Vineyard is located in the "Rocks District of Milton-Freewater", a sub-AVA of Walla Walla Valley in northeastern Oregon. The grapes here are sustainably grown and are noted for their minerality and concentration of flavors due to the unique terroir of the region. We currently source only Mourvédre from this vineyard but they also grow Grenache, Viognier, Grenache Blanc, Syrah, and Sangiovese.

#### **Winemaker Notes**

"This was my first time with this varietal and the vineyard so I wasn't sure what to expect. When I've tasted Mourvédre in the past, it usually comes from Spain and I've always noticed a savory note on the wine that I hoped to recreate. I love all the wines from "The Rocks" so my second goal was to maintain the true nature and characteristics of the varietal as well....using an appropriate yeast and neutral oak kept us on track and this one turned out to be my favorite wine of 2020." ~ Joshua Roznowski

## **Tasting Notes**

Our first "Rocks" wine...and it's a doozy. Dark garnet in color with medium body and tannins, the palate pops with bright red fruits (think pomegranate and raspberry), a touch of black peppercorn, and all that funk you know and love from the region!! Savor this one with some parmesan truffle fries or a mushroom risotto. Drink 2022-2030.
