



2020 Riesling

Vineyard

One of Walla Walla's premier vineyards, Les Collines Vineyard (The Foothills in French) lies at the base of the Blue Mountains in Walla Walla Valley. The soil is mostly Walla Walla Silt Loam, with some Athena Silt Loam resting on top of ancient gravel. Les Collines tends to have a longer than average growing season, warmer in the morning, cooler than average in the afternoon, and a greater number of growing degree days, making it perfect for Riesling.

Winemaker Notes

"I liked the inaugural vintage of our Riesling a lot but I'm always striving to make the wines better. I used a different yeast this year hoping to bring out some different aromatics and flavors while maintaining the Alsacean style that I like. The result was a little more complex and food-friendly wine with warmer flavors and great acid...but not too much acid. "~ Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

We think this wine tastes like the holidays! Full flavors of warm, baked red apples with a touch of baking spice are prevalent but complimented by notes of lemon zest and minerality. Fairly medium bodied for a white wine with a slight line of acidity that makes you long for another sip. Perfect for those fall get-togethers and holiday parties!
