



2020 Rosé of Pinot Noir

Vineyard

Breezy Slope Vineyard is prime wine grape land. While only 5 acres, this vineyard is located at the highest elevation in the entire Walla Walla AVA, at 1,780 feet! No irrigation is required, and they don't spray the vines with chemicals so the grapes grow and speak for themselves. This vineyard is one of the only (and best) Pinot games in town so naturally Josh would go to them for his favorite varietal!

Winemaker Notes

"My two favorite varieties to make Rosé with are Pinot Noir and Cabernet Franc. I always pick for Rosé intentionally...I don't like to bleed off of a red wine ferment as it really changes the profile. This vintage of Rosé was stylistically a perfect balance between the creaminess of the 2018 and the acidity of the 2019. I like to barrel ferment my Rosé to add dimension in terms of weight and mouthfeel. The biggest surprise (in a good way) was the amount of color we got. It is a perfect pink with only a four hour cold soak."~ Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

If Rosé is your favorite summer sipper, then you are going to want more than a few bottles of this! The aromas are enticing with splashes of watermelon, strawberry, and a hint of minerality that lets you know summer is here! These flavors carry over to the palate and are complemented by a natural and fresh juiciness that will keep the party going all night.
