The Grenache for this blend came from Cockburn Ranch Vineyard. Located at the southeast corner of the valley, in the foothills of the Blue Mountains, this is a prime growing area for Grenache. Our Syrah once again came from E'ritage Vineyard. We have loved the Syrah coming off this vineyard so it was a natural choice. And in this 3rd year of making Stinger71, we finally found a local source for Mourvedre...a "Rocks District" site named Los Rococos that is showing huge potential. All three vineyards are packed full of the terroir that has earned the Walla Walla Valley a place among the leading wine regions of the world.

Winemaker Notes

"I always set out to make the wine varietally...meaning make the Syrah as a Syrah should be and the same with Grenache and Mourvedre. Putting the blend together is all about balancing the acidity and delicateness of the Grenache with the meatiness and weight of the Syrah while managing the "funk" of the Mourvedre so it didn't overpower the others. I think we nailed it." ~ Joshua Roznowski

Tasting Notes

The Stinger71 is currently our only blend. Amy is a huge fan of the Rhone region so we named this wine after her call sign in her squadron when she flew Cobra helicopters in the Marine Corps. It's chill, easy-going, and drinks like a boss. Complex yet approachable with intertwined flavors of stewed strawberry, red and black currants, dried grass, and the smallest wisp of allspice, this is always the crowd favorite!!
