Los Rocosos Vineyard is located in the "Rocks District of Milton-Freewater", a sub-AVA of Walla Walla Valley in northeastern Oregon. The grapes here are sustainably grown and are noted for their minerality and concentration of flavors due to the unique terroir of the region. We currently source only Mourvédre and Grenache from this vineyard but they also grow Viognier, Grenache Blanc, Syrah, and Sangiovese.

Winemaker Notes

"When I've tasted Mourvédre in the past, it usually comes from Spain and I've always noticed a savory note on the wine that I hoped to recreate. I love all the wines from "The Rocks" so my second goal was to maintain the true nature and characteristics of the varietal as well....using an appropriate yeast and neutral oak kept us on track and this one turned out to be one of my favorites." ~ Joshua Roznowski

This vintage boasts savory aromas of black cherries and Damson plums, fresh tobacco leaf, and just a touch of sage. In beautiful contrast, the palate is refreshing with flavors of ripe cranberry and strawberry dancing across your tongue. Pair this with an Italian beef sando!! Drink 2023-2029.
